


Do Now Question #6

Class Supplies

- binder
- dividers: paper, homework, notes
- notebook paper lots of it
- 2 sheet protectors
- pencils lots of them with erasers
- pencil sharpener with a cover
- calculator inexpensive (must have square root and percent)

Supplies may be purchased in class.



Calculators

You will be using a calculator in 7th grade. But, not for the first few weeks. Please buy calculator that will last for the year. It does not have to be expensive. It must have a % sign, a square root sign √ and +/- buttons.



You must bring to class everyday:

- Your math binder. All math papers must be in the binder. Do not go hunting through your bookbag for your papers.
- Homework which is in your binder.
- Pencils, sharpener, paper, calculator.

Make sure you come to class prepared.



Bathroom Passes

You will be issued two bathroom passes each quarter. Use them when absolutely necessary. If you do not use them, you may turn them in for extra credit. Do not lose them!



Homework Passes

You will receive one homework pass each of the first three quarters. The homework pass allows you to turn in one late assignment. It does not exempt you from doing the assignment. Extra credit is given if all homework assignments are complete and you do not use it.

Extra Credit

For the first three weeks of school, extra credit points will be given if a parent signs your homework. On very rare occasions extra credit will be given during the year.



<u>Grading</u>

Each assignment will be given a point value. It is a more fair way to grade. The more work you do, the more points you can earn. Sometimes I will ask you how many problems you want for homework. The class will vote in a democratic process.



<u>Homework</u>

Homework assignments are due on time. They are not accepted late unless you have been absent. I will not chase after you for make-up work due to absences. It is up to you to turn it in. The assignment grade is a zero until it is made up (within two days of absence).
